## TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

1. Competitors must be in good standing with their National Association and since 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008, have been playing members of clubs affiliated to the BadmintonEngland or individual associate members of the BadmintonEngland. Competitors must be over the minimum age for the event that they have entered at midnight on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008.
2. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason, to limit the number of entries for any event and to alter or modify the programme in any way it sees fit. Its decision on all matters shall be final.
3. Entries on the official form, or photocopies thereof, should reach the Hon Tournament Secretary, with entry fees and a stamped self-addressed envelope, by **SATURDAY, 28<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2008. Each competitor must send in a separate entry form and entry fee.** Cheques and POs should be made payable to **LANCASHIRE COUNTY BADMINTON ASSOCIATION.**  
Competitors requiring a partner should enter 'partner wanted' in the Partners Name column of the form.
4. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times stated for the commencement of each event. If a later time is stated in the appropriate column of the entry form, the Committee will consider this, but no guarantee can be given.  
Competitors will be advised by post of the time of their first match in each event for which their entry has been accepted. If no such notification has been received by Tuesday, 19<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2007, it is the responsibility of the competitor to enquire from the Deputy Referee, Mr Yunus Suleman, 01772 254681 or 07774 8207549 (mobile) the times of their events.  
**ANY COMPETITOR NOT READY TO PLAY WHEN CALLED UPON WILL BE LIABLE TO BE SCRATCHED.**  
Competitors must report to the Referee immediately upon arrival, before changing, and must not leave the hall without the Referee's permission until eliminated from all events.  
Play shall not take place on days other than those sanctioned and no competitor shall be obliged to commence a match before 9.00 am or after 11.00 pm on any such day. Any competitor who is not prepared to play outside these times shall be entitled to a refund of their entry fee.
5. The tournaments are promoted by the Lancashire County Badminton Association and subject to the Regulations for Tournaments of the BadmintonEngland.
6. Events will be played in pools. **Rally points scoring system**
7. CLOTHING: BadmintonEngland clothing regulations shall apply. If in doubt then consult the Referee.
8. PENALTIES: The BadmintonEngland penalty clauses shall apply.
9. The winners in each event, and if sufficient entries are received, the runners-up shall receive mementoes.
10. Feathered shuttlecocks will be used.
11. **Drug testing: Sport England has introduced random drug testing. A Sport England Official could attend this tournament and carry out tests on any competitor. Any competitor found to have taken banned substances, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified from the tournament, reported to the BadmintonEngland and any prize won shall be returned to the Tournament Referee. A declaration appears on the entry form. Entries without this consent cannot be accepted.**
